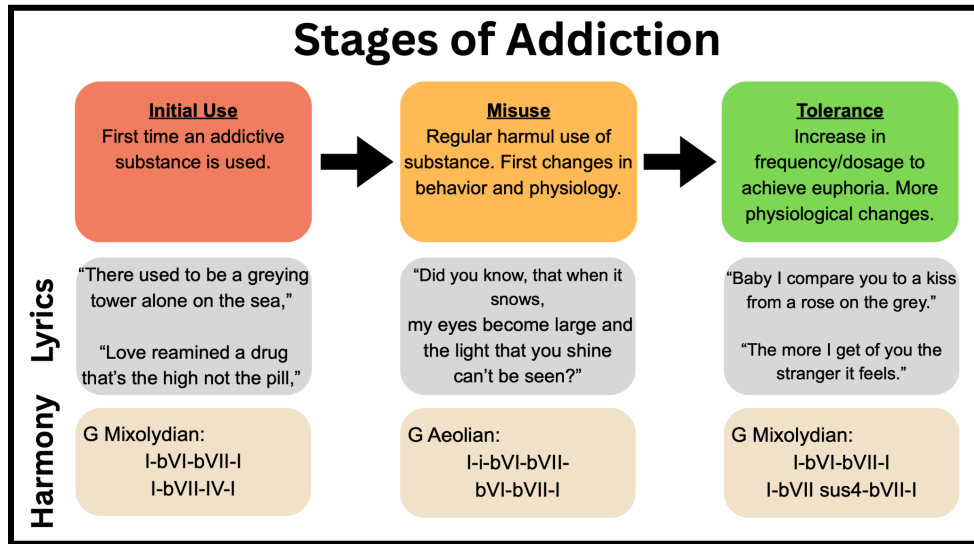

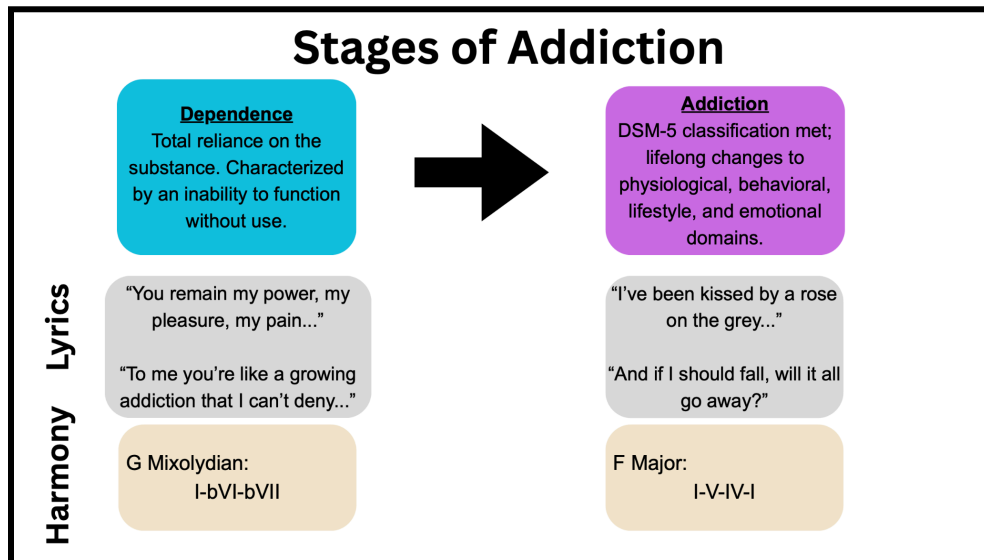
Example 1: The Narrative of Addiction in "Kiss from a Rose," part one
